About the Program

UNESCO Summer Peace and Diplomacy Program offers a two week of intensive lectures and discussions, and cultural exploration, organized by the UNESCO Chair on Cultural Diplomacy, Governance and Education. The program aims to equip students with an interdisciplinary perspective on contemporary global issues, by helping the participants understand international relations, global governance and cultural diplomacy. Within **intercultural workshops** participants engage in conflict resolution, storytelling and dialogues on peace education, gaining practical skills for global citizenship and advocacy for peace.

- Enhance knowledge of **International Relations and Foreign Policies**
- Foster how to apply key theories in international relations
- Explore **global values and their influence globally**
- Develop **intercultural communication skills and competence**
- Analyze the role of **cultural diplomacy** and various power types in global politics

Teaching Methodology

- Our program's courses are carefully designed to align with UNESCO's mission of promoting global peace, cultural understanding and diplomacy.
- Guided by the **UNESCO values**, we offer a unique learning experience that empowered participants to actively contribute to global peace initiatives.
- With a **non-ECTS format** and small classroom sizes, the program allow for deep engagement and **interactive learning**.
- Each course conclude with a **discourse session**, where participants practice their diplomatic communication skills, applying what they learn in real-world scenarios.



Intercultural Integration Workshops

- Our program's intercultural workshops foster dialogue, collaboration and mutual understanding among participants from diverse backgrounds.
- Through activities such as storytelling and peace education discussions, participants develop practical skills to navigate cultural differences and build meaningful connections.
- By promoting empathy and global citizenship, the program empowers participants to become agents of positive change in an interconnected world.

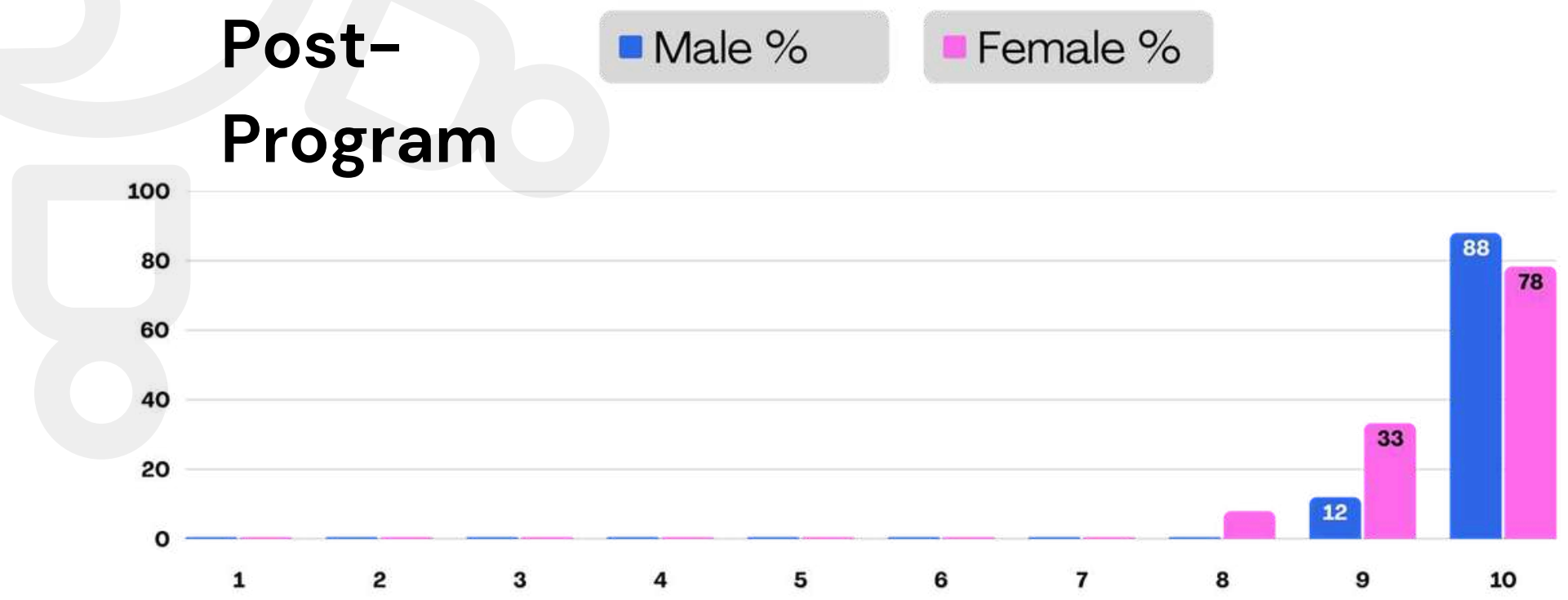
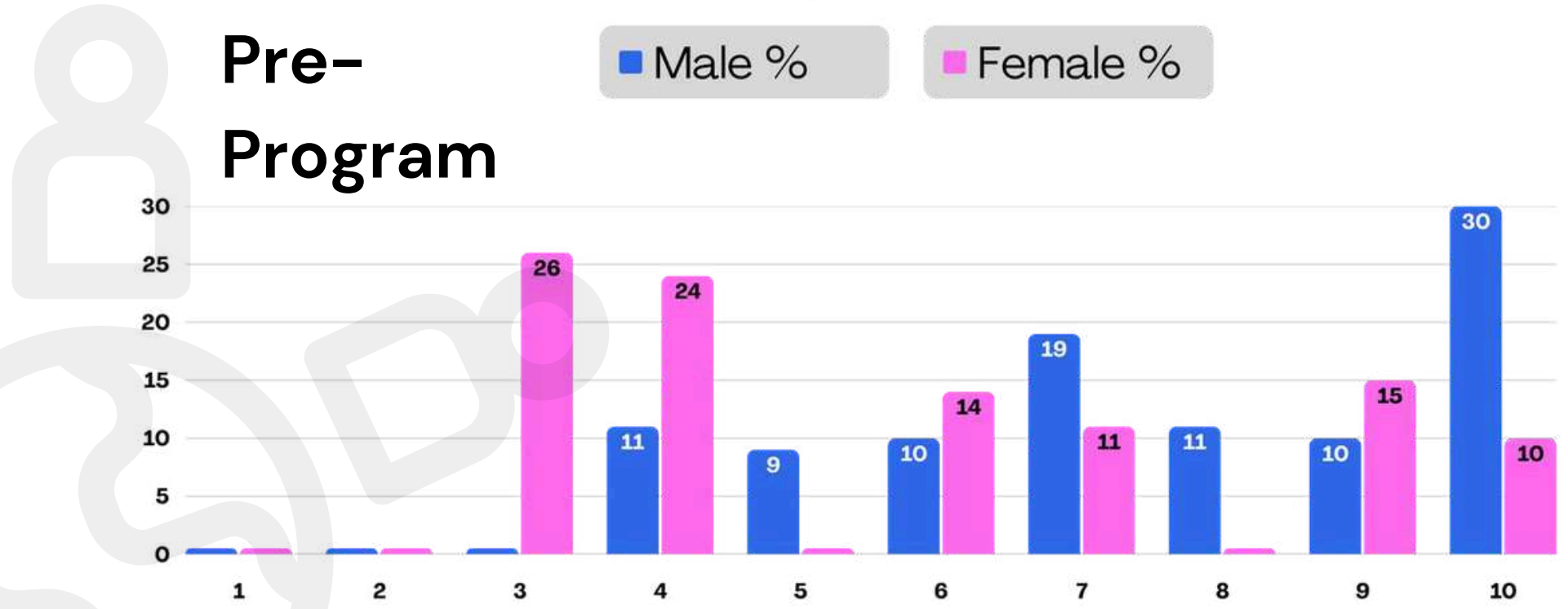
This dramatic change underscores the program's effectiveness in transforming viewpoints and enhancing understanding, clearly demonstrating the substantial impact of the experience.



Change in perspective towards Diversity and Inclusion

In the pre-program survey, it can be observed that most participants did not view diversity as an enriching element in society.

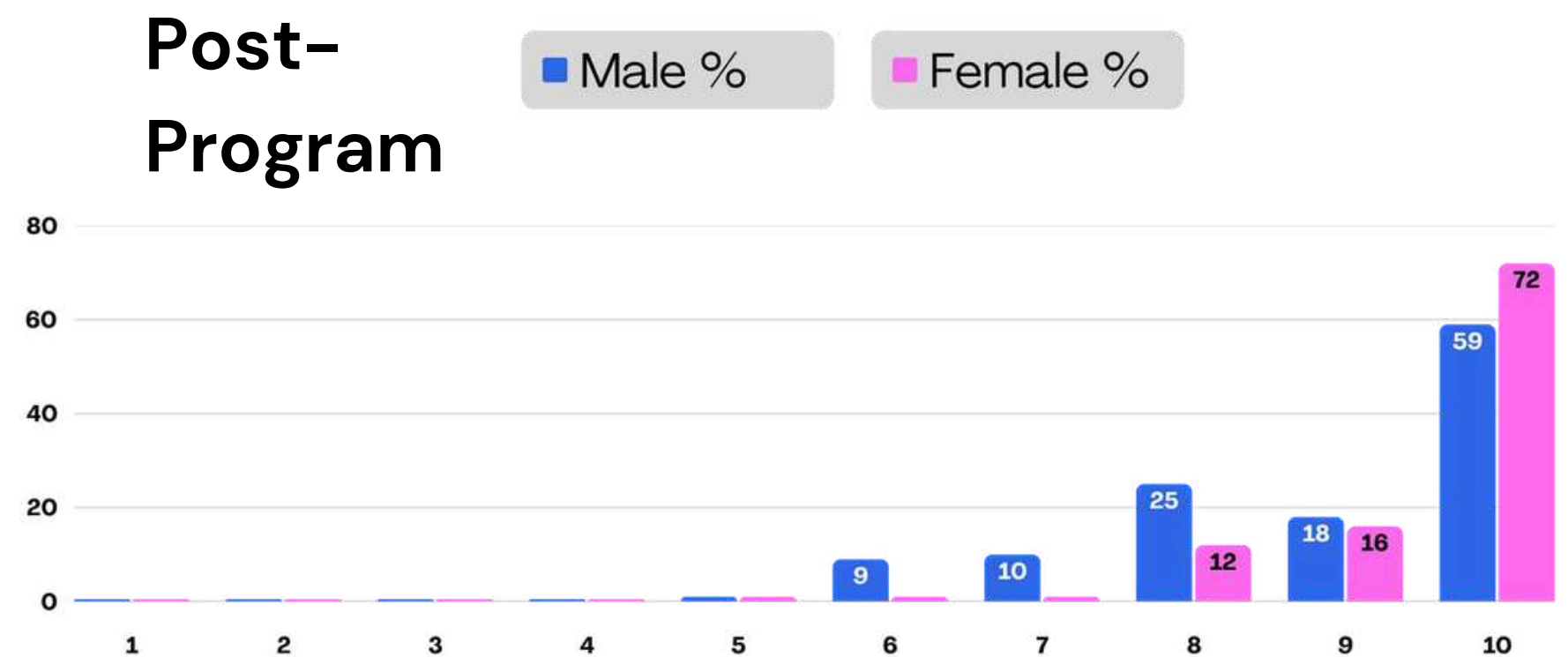
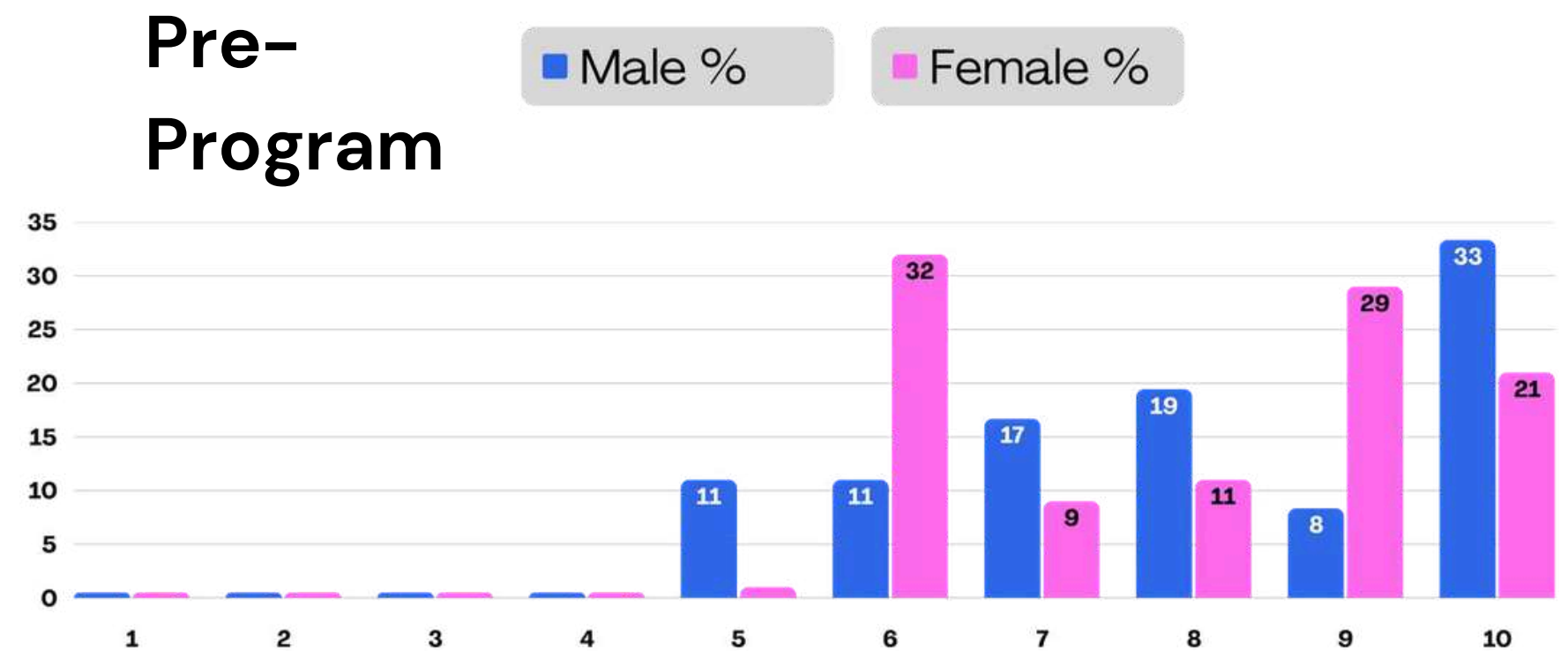
However, in the post-program survey, 90% of the participants began to agree strongly with diversity being an enriching element in society.



Change in understanding of International Relations and Global Issues

In the pre-program survey, it was seen that participants had a very minimal understanding of International Relations and Global Issues.

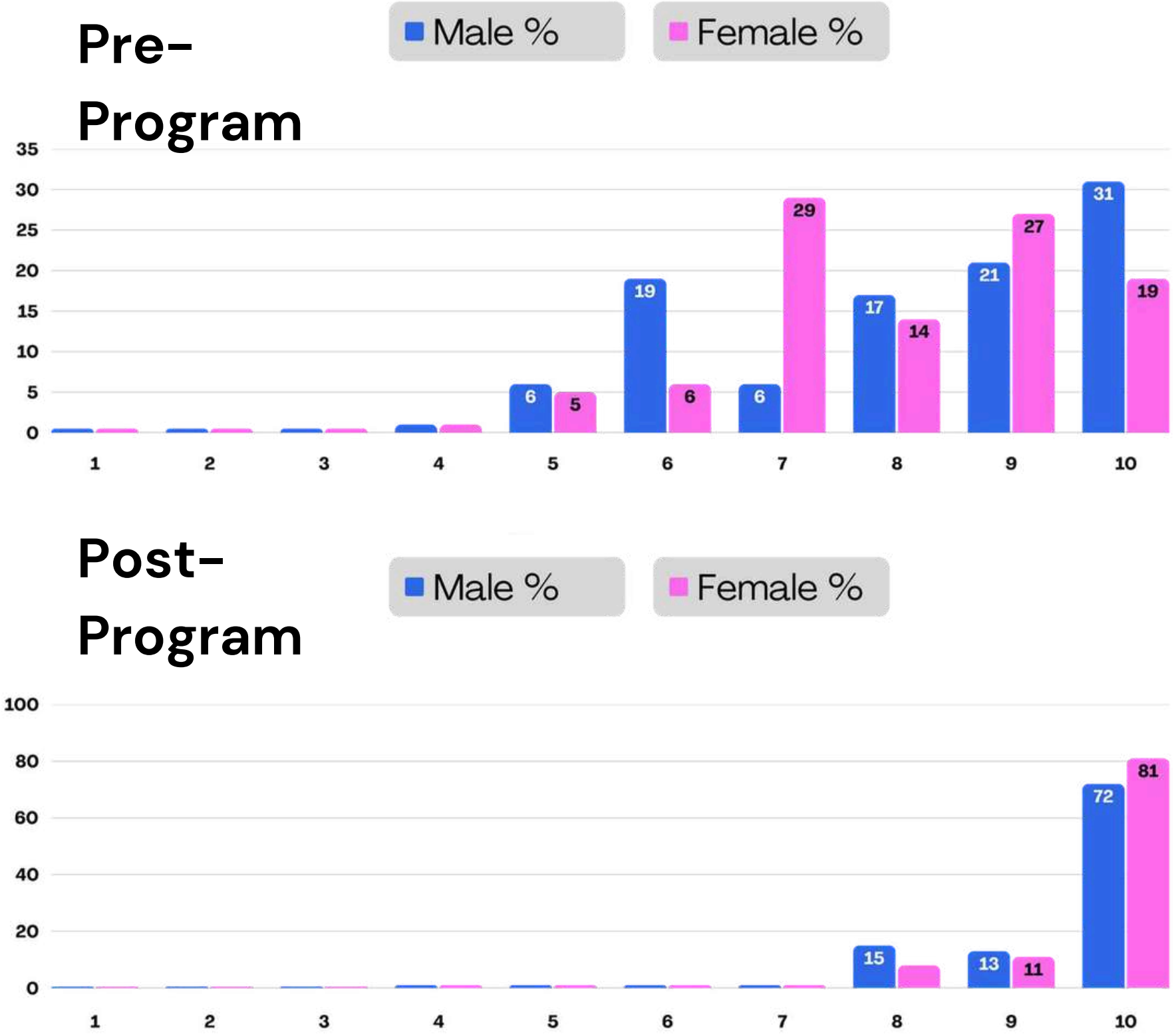
In the post-program survey, a significant increase in knowledge regarding these topics can be observed.



Familiarity regarding International Organizations

We observed an increase in the knowledge and familiarity that participants had regarding international organizations (e.g., United Nations, UNESCO, World Health Organization etc).

Additionally, many participants displayed an interest in joining and becoming a part of these organizations.

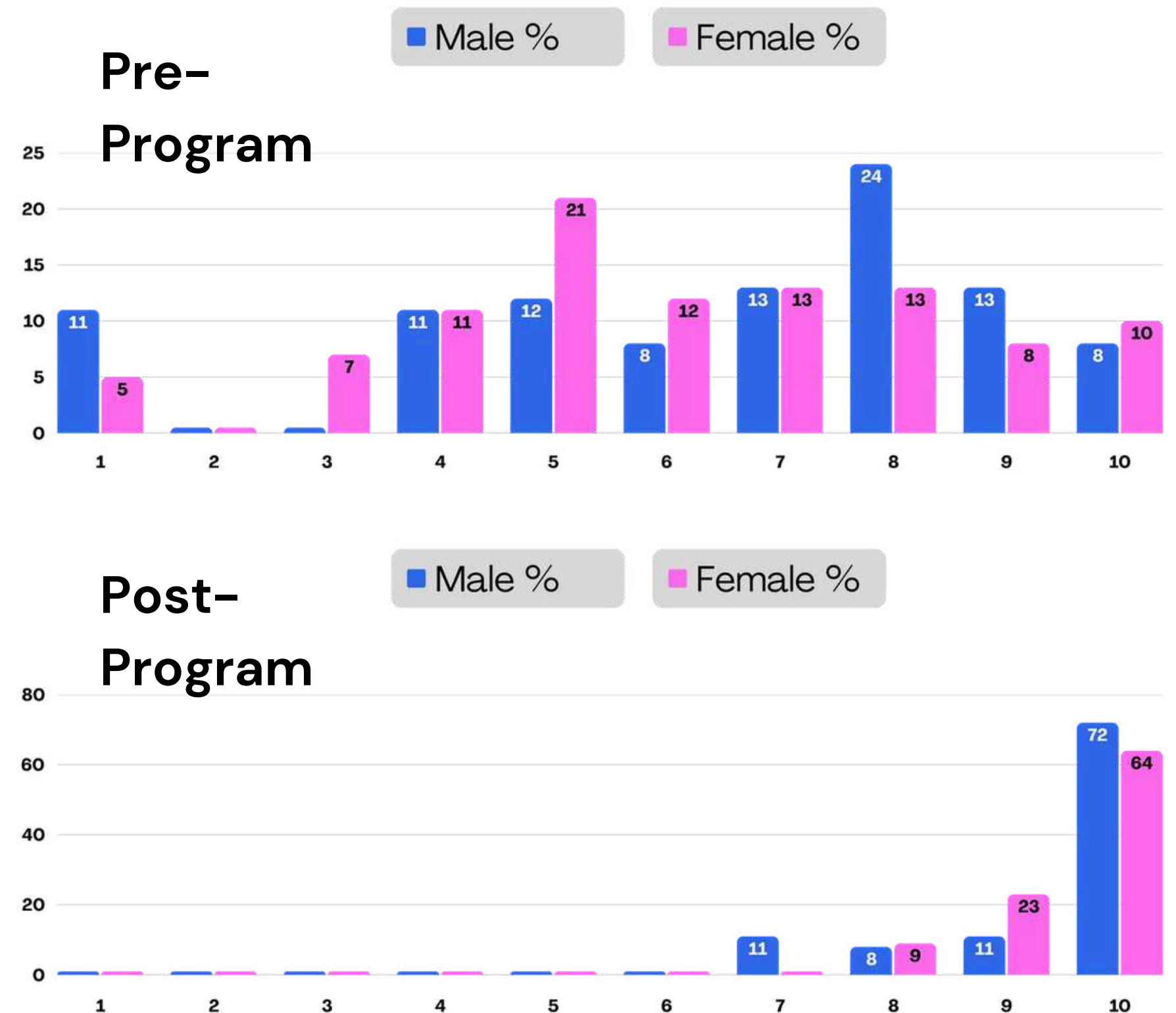


Shift in willingness to challenge own cultural biases and stereotypes when engaging with different cultural norms and practices

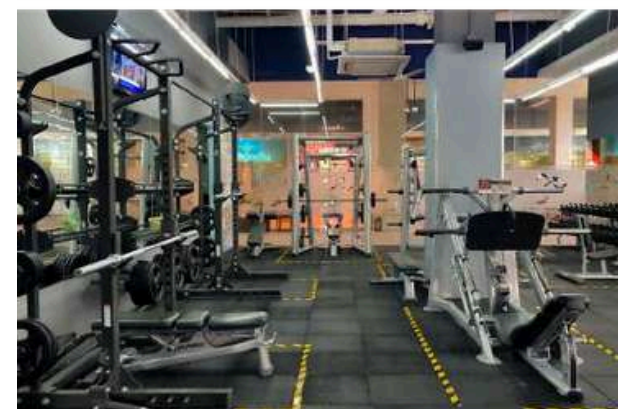
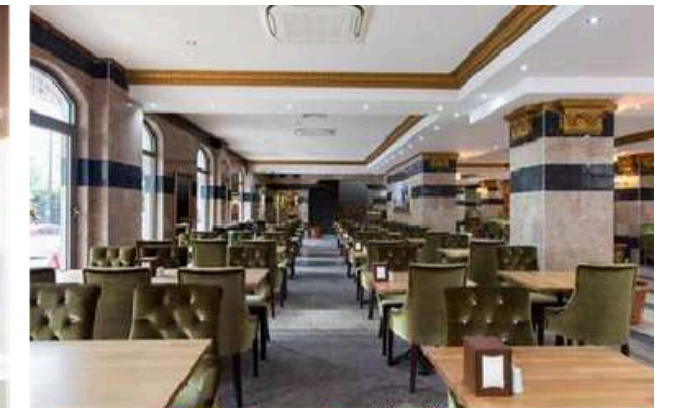
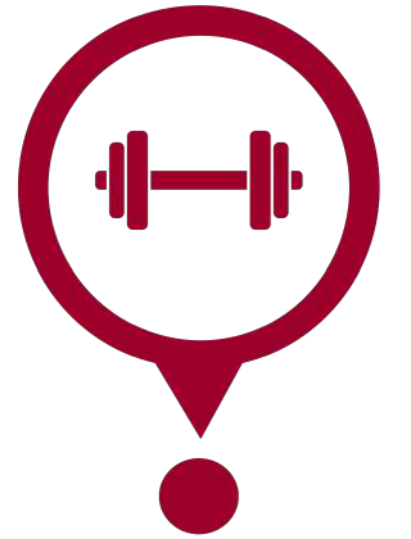
